



Philly Refinery Environmental Cleanup

What is the Philadelphia Refinery environmental cleanup?

- Evergreen is completing environmental investigation and cleanup at the former Philadelphia Refinery under the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) Land Recycling Program (Act 2).
- Evergreen will continue the environmental investigation and cleanup activities in coordination with the proposed redevelopment of the property.
- This information is being provided to residences/businesses/organizations located within proximity of the Refinery as part of Evergreen's Public Involvement Plan.



What progress has been made on the environmental cleanup?

- Environmental investigations have been conducted by Evergreen across the entire facility. These investigations provide a picture of the environmental conditions at the facility.
- Interim cleanup activities have included removal and treatment of groundwater, oil, soil and soil vapors.
- All investigation and remediation activities are performed in coordination with the PADEP and EPA. Environmental reports documenting progress can be found at www.phillyrefinerycleanup.info. Electronic report copies are also available at the Eastwick and Shunk St library branches.
